How will results from the NWEA Map testing help my child in areas that are weak.

The results from the NWEA Measure of Academic Progress (MAP) tests will be used to identify strengths and weaknesses in your child’s learning. STM will be implementing the RtI (Response to Intervention) model school-wide which will match the student’s weakness to specific interventions and progress monitoring. The quick turn-around of test results paired with the RtI program will identify the gaps in student learning early so remediation can take place in a timely manner.
