17-18 ENROLLMENT PROCESS

To register a student for the 2017-2018 school year:

1. Log into ParentsWeb at www.renweb.com.
2. Select **Logins** from the menu bar and **ParentsWeb Login** from the drop-down menu.
3. Type in your username and password. If you have forgotten your username or password, please click on the link provided. If you have not previously created a Parents Web login, contact Sandra Steele at ssteele@stm-school.com.
4. After logging in, click on the **Family Information** button in the left menu.
5. Click on the **Enrollment/Reenrollment** button.
6. This will open up the enrollment for your student(s). Please review the information, make any corrections, and add any missing information.

- **Hot Lunch Prices:**
Student - \$2.20
Adult - \$2.85
- **Cash or Check Payments Accepted**
Checks made out to STM are accepted.
- **Families with more than one student:**
Eating hot lunch are encouraged to send in ONE check (or cash) in one envelope.
Money will be divided between siblings accordingly.
- **There is a \$10.00 charge limit per account**
If students do not bring in money after 5 charges, they will not be allowed in the hot lunch line until payment is made. However, students will be offered a cheese sandwich if they have nothing else to eat.
- **Students should turn in payment in a SEALED envelope labeled as follows:**
