





PLAN AHEAD!

Orders will be processed as usual on the week of 3/18, but please note that TRIP orders will not be processed for the following 2 weeks--March 25 (STM spring break) and April 1 (supplier holiday). The next time to order will be after Easter (Monday 4/8), so make sure you order everything you need for Easter gifts/holiday celebrations no later than 3/18 and stock up on grocery and gas TRIP cards.

OR DON'T PLAN AHEAD!

If you have an active PrestoPay account, you'll be able to order scripNOW and reload gift cards during spring break and the supplier holiday when no orders will be processed at STM. Remember, the last 2 steps for setting up a PrestoPay account are to verify your account information by typing in the two small amounts deposited in your bank account by Great Lakes Scrip Center and then sending the four digit approval code to our STM TRIP Coordinator (Susan Anglin).
